## Class 67 Locomotives

**225GROUP** 

A total of 30 Class 67 diesel-electric locomotives were built by Alstom in Valencia (Spain) during 1999 and 2000 and were numbered 67001 to 67030.

They have been employed on a wide variety of work, including passenger/freight services, charter operations, the Royal Train and the Belmond 'British Pullman'. For several years, they were used as 'Thunderbird' locomotives on the East Coast Mainline (ECML), hauling InterCity 225s in the event of breakdowns, engineering work and other disruption. Since 2019, 12 have been modified to work in push-pull mode with Mark 4 rolling stock on Transport for Wales 'premier' services from South Wales to Manchester and Holyhead, making them a key part of the InterCity 225 story.

The panel opposite contains technical details for the Class 67, while the table below provides information about all the locomotives, including when they were commissioned, the names they have carried and their current status.

## Class 67 Locomotives



### General Notes

67002 is fitted with European Train Control System (ETCS) in-cab signalling equipment.

67004, 67007, 67009, 67011 and 67030 are fitted with Radio Electronic Token Block (RETB) signalling equipment.

67007 carries a special purple and white livery celebrating the Platinum Jubilee (70<sup>th</sup> year on the throne) of Queen Elizabeth II.

67008, 67010, 67012, 67013, 67014, 67015, 67016, 67017, 67020, 67022, 67025 and 67029 have been modified to operate in push-pull mode with Transport for Wales Mark 4 rolling stock.

67018 is all over red, including roof and solebar.

67026 carries a special silver livery celebrating the Diamond Jubilee (60<sup>th</sup> year on the throne) of Queen Elizabeth II.

67029 is all over silver with a black solebar.
